DAY 1 | Arrive in Tangier

Arrive in Tangier, where you will be met at the airport by Tangier Campus staff. Check-in, freshen up, campus tour. Walking tour of the neighborhood and possible cultural orientation. Then, a late group welcome lunch or welcome dinner.

DAY 2 | Tangier

Breakfast. Tour of Tangier's medina. Group lunch near the Kasbah. Site visit with local organization. Possible departure for Kenitra for 8 a.m. conference.

DAY 3 | Kenitra

Attend conference. Lunch and dinner on your own. Free time and reflections.

DAY 4 | Asilah

Breakfast. Local activity including camel rides. Group lunch in Asilah, a laid-back town on the Atlantic coast. Dinner on your own. Free time and reflections.

Breakfast. Site visit with local organization. Lunch on your own. School based activity and cultural activities. Dinner on your own. Free time and reflections.

DAY 6 | Tangier

Breakfast. Creative occupation and class. Lunch on your own. Learn to make a Morocco meal and enjoy dinner at a cooking class. Free time and reflections.

DAY 7 | Tetouan

Breakfast. Visit Tetouan, a historical city near the Mediterranean. Beach time and farewell group lunch. Packing and goodbyes. Free time and dinner your own.

DAY 8 | Return Home

Breakfast. Transfer to airport and return to United States or continue travels on your own in Morocco or Europe.
